

Husky Camp Altevatn



Our base camp on the 50 kilometre long Lake Altevatn is central to this tour. It will be the starting point for trips lasting one or more days, to the southern parts of Dividalen National Park and to the Norwegian-Swedish border.

This base camp is a modest cabin, that can be reached within one or two days dog sledding across Lake Altevatn – depending on the snow conditions. From here a number of more challenging tours can be arranged.

Other cabins can also be visited from here. The majestic mountains and the lower forests offer numerous alternatives. In addition, the lakes are great for ice fishing. In total you will be 5 days on the expedition.

Participants may handle their own sled and dog team. So everyone has the responsibility to harness the dogs and feed them.

Before the tour starts you will be given an extensive day long introduction to dog sledding. Quickly you will understand the most important lessons and your skill will continue to improve during the tour.

To handle the dogs and the sledge is a main issue on each tour. The tour guide will lead the first team, and will be available to assist you whenever necessary.

For this tour you need general fitness, a love of the outdoors and dogs and enjoy a challenge.
