

Norwegian Mountain Expedition

8 days/7 nights/6 days dog sledding
26th March to 2nd April 2012 (Monday to Monday)



Spring is a beautiful time in the mountains with long days which are often lovely and sunny with cold, clear nights. On this adventure you will get to spend 4 nights in a tent/lavvo where you will see how easy and it is to sleep outdoors in these temperatures in your snug sleeping bag.

Tuesday

Meet at Trondheim airport and transfer to accommodation where you can relax and settle in, go for a walk or visit the dog kennels and meet the huskies.



They love to be petted and you can visit them at any time and you can help to feed them also. You can of course just sit and relax with a good book in the lounge. Dinner, overnight in guide's house or nearby cabin.

Wednesday

After breakfast we get our overalls and boots and learn how to harness the dogs and manage a sled. Then we go out on our day tour so that you can get to feel comfortable with your sled and team of dogs. We will return back to the kennel for dinner and overnight.



Thursday to Monday

The next 5 days will be spent in the stunning winter landscape where we will stay at a different camp each night. Everyone helps to set up camp, feed the dogs and cook the dinner. We will travel 15 to 35km each day depending on the weather and snow conditions. We return to the kennels on Monday afternoon for our last night. We will share a nice dinner where we can share

experiences of our week and you will also be able to have a warm shower – bliss!

Tuesday

Today we have to say goodbye to the happy huskies and return to the airport and home, we hope with some amazing memories.

Cost: £2250 per person

Group size: Min 2 Max 8

2012 departures: 26th March to 2nd April – (Mon to Mon)



On this adventure you drive your own team of Alaskan huskies. 2 nights before and 1 after the tour you stay in the guide's house, single or double room or shared or at a cabin nearby, then on tour you camp in a tent or 'lavvo' (tepee). The group carries all the supplies with them. Everyone helps with taking care of the dogs and with the camp routines. **Suitable for anyone prepared for a challenge.**

Included:

Transfers from and to Trondheim airport, dinner or supper on arrival day, all meals on tour and breakfast on your departure day, 3 nights in warm accommodation with facilities and 4 nights in tent/lavvo on the tour. Special outer clothing plus camping and dog sledding equipment.

Not included:

Flights, travel insurance.
