Norwegian Airports

Oslo, Norway

Oslo is the capital of Norway and the centre of the most populous region of the country. From Oslo there are frequent air, rail and bus connections to the rest of the country.

Oslo is being serviced by three airports. [Oslo Airport Gardermoen](#), which is the major Norwegian airport and is located 37 km to the north east of Oslo. [Torp Airport](#) which is used by Ryanair is located 84 km to the south of Oslo. [Rygge Airport](#) was opened in 2007 and is located 59 km to the south.

Oslo Airport Gardermoen. An express train links the airport with Oslo. Trains run every ten minutes with a journey time of 20 minutes.

Trondheim, Norway

Trondheim is the third largest city in Norway and also a regional capital. The city is located in central Norway and is the host of the NTNU university.

Trondheim is served by [Trondheim Værnes airport](#) located 28 km to the east from Trondheim.

Bardufoss, Norway

Bardufoss is located in the county of Troms in northern Norway. Bardufoss consists of the communities of Andselv, Heggli and Andslimoen. Bardufoss has a population of around 2.200.

There are several airports near Bardufoss, [Bardufoss Airport](#), [Tromsø airport](#) and [Evenes airport](#).

Bardufoss Airport is located 2 km to the south east from Bardufoss. Bardufoss airport serves the entire central Troms region. This is primarily a military airport, but with some civilian flights. There is no airport bus, but public bus transport is available from Bardufoss.

Kirkenes, Norway

Kirkenes is a port town located in north eastern Norway close to the border with Russia. Kirkenes has around 6.000 inhabitants.

Kirkenes is served by [Kirkenes Høybuktnoen Airport](#) 6 km to the west from Kirkenes.

Alta, Norway

Alta is the administrative centre of the Finnmark region of Norway. Alta has around 15.000 inhabitants.

[Alta airport](#) is located 4 km to the east from Alta.

Tromsø, Norway

Tromsø is a charming city located on Tromsøya island in northern Norway, about 400 km north of the arctic circle.

There are two airports near Tromsø - Tromsø airport and [Bardufoss Airport](#)

Bergen, Norway

Bergen is an old trading city founded in 1070 by King Olav Kyrre. Today Bergen is a charming city rich on sights and culture and an ideal starting point for visiting the Norwegian Fjords.

[Bergen Airport Flesland](#) the airport nearest to Bergen, 12 km to the south west of Bergen. [Ryanair](#) fly into [Haugesund Airport](#) which is located some distance south of Bergen.

Bergen Airport Flesland is a modern airport with both domestic and international flights. There is a frequent bus service to Bergen and all the major international rental car companies are represented at the airport.

Narvik, Norway

Narvik is a harbour city in northern Norway, not far from the Lofoten islands.

There are two airports near Narvik served by low cost airlines: [Evenes airport](#) and [Bardufoss Airport](#). Evenes airport is located 31 km to the west from Narvik.

Bodø, Norway

Bodø is the second largest city in northern Norway and a good starting point for anyone wanting to visit the Lofoten islands. From Bodø there are ferry services to Stamsund, Moskenes and other places in Lofoten.

Bodø is served by [Bodø airport](#) located 2 km to the south west from Bodø.
