

Swedish Husky Adventure



A taste of the wilderness for anyone who would like to try out a real adventure. Discover the beauty the snow covered mountains have to offer. We spend our days travelling with the dogs, you get your own team to run and take care of during your stay. After a day in the mountains you can enjoy a warm and cosy bed at the Husky Lodge. One of the nights we spend in the mountains – in tents or a mountain cabin be ready for an adventure!

Day 1:

Arrival day. You will be met at airport (or train station) and transferred to Husky Lodge. We say 'hello' to the dogs, then we have dinner and discuss our coming adventure. Overnight at the Husky Lodge.

Day 2:

Dog sledding instruction and training day (including snowshoe walk) in the area around the Husky Lodge. We collect wood and make a fire and have lunch over the open fire. Dinner and overnight at Husky Lodge.

Day 3:

At breakfast we look at the weather and then make a day trip with our dog teams to the mountains or in forest terrain – both of which are really nice. Maybe we will see some tracks of wolverines or lynx. Back at the lodge, we feed the dogs and then make our dinner and make plans for the next day.

Day 4:

We pack the car and travel 40km and there our tour starts from Höglekardalen. Our dogs are eager to go!! The start is uphill so we need to work as a team and assist the dogs by running behind the sled. After about 3 hours we stop for lunch and give our dogs some snacks – we have all worked hard! Overnight in cabin or tent depending on weather. Dinner and nice open fire.

Day 5:

Continue travelling through the mountains in part on snowshoes and if the weather is nice we can stop and soak up the beautiful views and 'hear' the silence. Then with our dogs we will go through

breathtaking scenery in the wilderness. We stop for lunch perhaps by an open creek. At the end of the day we drive back to the lodge. We have a shower and last dinner together where we can share our adventure and photos. Overnight at the Husky Lodge.

Day 6:

Departure after breakfast to airport (or train station)

Cost: £1295

Dates: on request (Dec to April)

Duration: 6 days, 5 nights

Group size: 2 to 4 persons

Included:

4 nights in double room at the Husky Lodge
1 night in tent or cottage in the mountains
3 days of dog sledding with your own team in the mountains
1 day of dog sledding near the lodge with snowshoe hiking
All meals from dinner on day 1 to breakfast on day 6
Special outer clothing, sleeping bag & mattress
Guide on the tours and activities
Participation in the daily care of the dogs at the kennel
Transfer from and to airport or train station



The 'Husky Lodge'

Located by the sled dog kennels, the lodge is next to the guides' home. The lodge is in modern Swedish country style and has been renovated in 2007. The lodge consists of 2 mini-suites for 2 persons each - with bedroom, lounge, TV and WC. The bathroom is shared. There are 2 extra beds in the guides' house, if necessary.

Optional choice:

Spend a day and night at a Sámi village in the mountains. The sled dogs will take us to the Sámi camp. We have a nice dinner, wood fired outdoor bath, lecture by the Sámi people... after breakfast the next day we continue our husky safari. Upon request only, not included, £185 per person (minimum 4 persons).



How to get there

The sled dog kennel is located in Jämtland which is in the middle of Sweden between Åre and Östersund. Transfers are arranged from Östersund airport or Järpen train station.

SAS & FlyNordic fly from Stockholm Arlanda to Östersund airport (or you can go by train). If you are flying into Trondheim, Norway you can take the "Nabotåget" to Järpen.
