

# Swedish Lapland Husky Tour

4 days / 3 nights / 2 days on the husky tour



**This trip is in Swedish Lapland – North of the arctic circle!**

## Day 1:

You arrive in the afternoon/evening, transfer to base and have dinner or snack (depending on how late you arrive) and then stay the night at the Husky base camp.

## Days 2 & 3:

After instruction you will lead your own team of huskies on an amazing trip through forest land and across frozen rivers staying in simple wilderness cabins for the 2 nights. Lunch by a fire or in a simple hut.

## Day 4:

After breakfast you will take your dogs back to base camp, arriving 10am. Transfer to airport.

You can start on any day of the week - the sooner you book the better it is for choosing your own dates - and there is a minimum of 2 people per trip.. This trip is very popular, partly because not everyone has a week spare, partly because you might just like to 'try' dog sledding and also because you can take teenagers and children too. (although younger children and some teenagers will need to ride in the sled).



The accommodation is in cabins in bunk beds with no running water. Heating is provided by a wood burning stove and lighting by candles. The loo is outside. It is a 'hands on' trip where you are actively encouraged to look after your dogs, i.e. feed and water them and bed them down for the night (under supervision), fetch water, chop wood so you get the true feeling of being a 'musher'.

A visit to the Ice Hotel can be made during the trip This must be booked in advance and paid locally in Swedish Krone (around £35). It's worth a visit to see the ice sculptures and take photos.

You can also add igloo building, snowmobile adventures, XC skiing, reindeer farm visit, ice fishing and more .... according to how much time you have to spare. Ask Gill for details or see the 'Swedish Lapland Adventures' on the multi-activity page of our website.

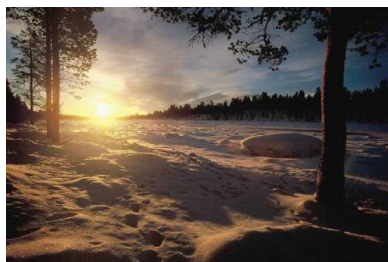
Extra night's accommodation (half board) in a simple cabin at the base is £90 per person per night.

**Cost: £675 per person (excluding 21<sup>st</sup> Dec to 2<sup>nd</sup> Jan when the cost will be £775)**

**Departures:** upon request from mid December to mid April

**Included:** transfers from and to the airport, full board, an English speaking guide, extra outer clothes needed for protection from the cold, sled and your own team of huskies.

**Not included:** flights, travel insurance
