

Swedish Husky Adventure



A taste of the wilderness for anyone who would like to try out a real adventure. Discover the beauty the snow covered mountains have to offer. We spend our days travelling with the dogs, you get your own team to run and take care of during your stay. After a day in the mountains you can enjoy a warm and cosy bed in 2 of the cabins belonging to the Sami people..... be ready for an adventure!

Day 1:

Arrival day. You will be met at airport (or train station) and transferred to Husky Lodge. We say 'hello' to the dogs, then we have dinner and discuss our coming adventure. Overnight at the Husky Lodge.

Day 2: We pack the car and set off to the mountains. Our dogs are eager to go!! The start is uphill so we need to work as a team and assist the dogs by running behind the sled. After about 3 hours we stop for lunch and give our dogs some snacks – we have all worked hard! After lunch we continue until we reach the cabin. While we have a nice dinner and a good fire going, the dogs are resting. Overnight in cabin.

Day 3: We wake up in the mountain and after feeding the dogs and ourselves, we put on the snow shoes to check out the area. Hopefully, it's a nice morning....take the chance to sit down and soak in the beautiful view and listen to the silence. In this area there are plenty of wolverines and lynx, maybe we see some tracks, and if we are lucky also an animal. The wolf often goes through this area. Arriving at the second night camp, a Sami camp with cabins and a small personal restaurant. We are being served a 2 course dinner with local delicacies. After dinner you can take a shower and spend some time in the wood fired sauna.

Day 4: We wake up the last morning on our tour and we have breakfast in the restaurant today. Its time to go with the dogs, and they will take you through breathtaking scenery among the magnificent mountains and wilderness of Sweden. We stop for lunch...maybe by an open creek so you can get a taste of clean & fresh mountain water. At the end of the day, we say farewell to the mountains & we drive back to the Husky lodge. After shower and our last dinner together we take a look at all the nice pictures we have taken and talk about our adventure.

Day 5: After breakfast its time to say goodbye to the dogs, the guide & Jämtland. Hopefully, with a lot of nice memories that will last for a lifetime!

Dates: 19th to 23rd March 2012

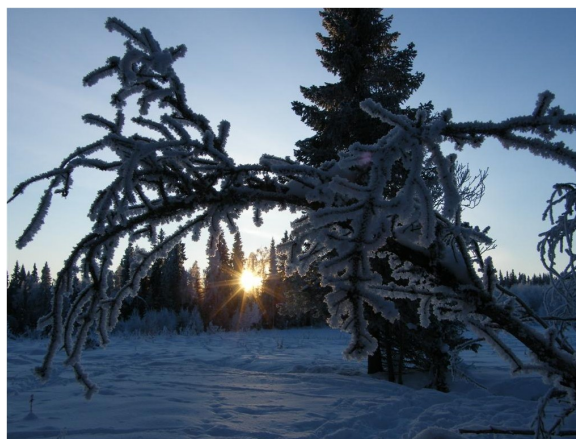
Cost: £1375 per person

Duration: 5 days, 4 nights

Group size: 2 to 4 persons

Included:

2 nights in double room at the Husky Lodge
2 nights in cabins in the mountains
At the Sami camp, 2 course dinner and breakfast, sauna and shower
3 days of dog sledding with your own team in the mountains
All meals from dinner on day 1 to breakfast on day 5
Special outer clothing, sleeping bag & mattress
Guide on the tours and activities
Participation in the daily care of the dogs at the kennel
Transfer from and to airport or train station
Day trips between 10-50km



The 'Husky Lodge'

Located by the sled dog kennels, the lodge is next to the guides' home. The lodge is in modern Swedish country style and has been renovated in 2007. The lodge consists of 2 mini-suites for 2 persons each - with bedroom, lounge, TV and WC. The bathroom is shared. There are 2 extra beds in the guides' house, if necessary.

** Please be aware that the tour can be changed due to adverse weather and snow conditions.*



How to get there

The sled dog kennel is located in Jämtland which is in the middle of Sweden between Åre and Östersund. Transfers are arranged from Östersund airport or Järpen train station.

SAS & Norwegian fly from Stockholm Arlanda to Östersund airport (or you can go by train). If you are flying into Trondheim, Norway you can take the "Nabotåget" to Järpen.
